

Bus Reimbursement

2019 Georgia Frontiere Cinema for Students Program

Cinema St. Louis — thanks to a major gift from the [Hawkins Foundation](#) — will pay for up to \$400 per school in busing costs. In special cases, we can exceed this amount; inquire when booking a program.

Although all schools are eligible for reimbursement, we ask those schools that are able to afford buses to allow schools with more limited financial resources to use this benefit.

We have a \$10,000 cap, so reimbursement will be handled on a first-come, first-served basis; early registration for programs is thus encouraged.

If a school plans to apply for reimbursement, we require an estimate of busing costs at the time reservations for programs are made.

To receive reimbursement, schools should fill out the information below and **attach receipts** for your busing costs. Again, there is a cap of \$400 per school (unless you've been approved in advance to exceed that amount).

Forms need to be postmarked by no later than Dec. 6. We absolutely require that receipts arrive by that date. Schools that send information with a postmark after Dec. 6 will not receive reimbursement.

Reimbursement will be sent within two weeks of receipt of form/invoice.
